From time to time, we have a member who lives in a group home and they have a medical issue. They may be in the hospital for weeks and then in rehabilitation.

Sometimes their recovery has problems, and they need to return to the hospital. This can leave them out of their group home for not just weeks but months. The families and loved ones of our members are involved in the recovery of our ill members. They are concerned with their medical problems, and making sure they get the needed treatment and care.

BUT there is another problem happening. The group home is not being paid. Most group homes budgets are based on 6 people, so when the group home is not being paid for one person that is 1/6 of that group home's budget. The group home must make a hard choice. They cannot keep operating with that room not being paid for.

The group home does not have the income to pay the bills. They need to replace the sick person who is in the hospital or rehabilitation facility with a paying resident. So, the sick person now loses their home.

The issue is that Medicaid pays for the group home. Medicaid will not pay for two placements at the same time. Medicaid will not pay for the group home and the hospital (or rehabilitation facility) at the same time. Perhaps someone could private pay, but who can afford to do so?

It is our opinion that APD needs to make provisions to reimburse group homes with general revenue dollars when group home residents are in a hospital or rehabilitation facility.

Did You Know?

32% of people with intellectual and developmental differences (IDD)have a co-occurring mental illness.*

The reality of residential options for many individuals with IDD is not as simple as lacking a home, but rather a living situation that does not set them up for success.

Currently, individuals with mental health needs combined with intellectual and developmental differences do not have a place to live on their own.

The Lodge: Florida's first affordable community home providing mental health services for individuals with IDD. Built adjacent to The Arc Jacksonville Village, The Lodge provides independent living skills training, supervision, assistance, and critical mental health services in a residential home environment.
